Nominal prizes would be awarded at the evo* closing ceremony on 29 April 2011, but the main purpose is for winners to obtain recognition by the evo* community.

Competition organisers should prepare a proposal to include:

- * description of the problem addressed;
- * description of the data and a web link for downloads;
- * evaluation procedures and established baselines;
- * an estimation of the number of participants;
- * the specific evo* event or events the competition is relevant to;
- * possible sources of sponsorship, if any;
- * short bios of the proposers, including experience in similar events.
